- A provider who has taken a leadership role in a group or organization that serves children, families or providers.

The qualifications for a candidate are as follows:

- Certified or Licensed Provider in the state of Wisconsin
- Holds no serious non-compliances with the state or county in which they are regulated
- Must be attending the 2019 WFCCA Conference- May 2-4 at Chula Vista in WI Dells
- May not have already won the Member of the Year Award or the Governor’s Award

- All applicants will be reviewed and the winner will be chosen by a non-partisan panel, selected by the WFCCA Provider of the Year Committee, based on the qualities and actions of the provider that reflect the Mission of WFCCA.
- Applications are open to all individuals without discrimination based on age, race, color, creed, national origin, gender, political persuasion, handicap or religion.
