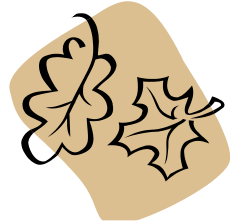

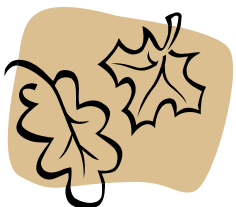

This workshop is all about active play and how you can incorporate it into your program on a daily basis. The activities are based on the work of Dr. Diane Craft. Professor Craft teaches in the Physical Education Department at State University of New York at Cortland. She has won numerous professional awards for her work, and has given over 100 presentations and workshops on preschool physical activities to local, state, national and international audiences. Her focus is to improve the physical activity opportunities for preschool children with and without disabilities. This focus morphed into her book, Active Play.

You will learn the activities through playing yourself! All activities are geared to all developmental ages and stages. A two year old can have as much fun as a 6 year old with special needs or a 90 year old! Come in comfortable clothes and be prepared to participate in the activities-you will not only get some physical activity, but you will also have so much fun!
